



This is a hands-on position focused on flipping, stacking, sorting, counting, measuring, and labeling a wide variety of green and kiln-dried lumber and timbers. Accuracy and safe material handling are essential.

The job entails indoor and outdoor work depending on production needs with exposure to noise, dust, and changing weather.

Role Scope and Qualification

Role Scope

- Assist the Area Lead with material flow and handling throughout the production area
- Flip, stack, align, and strap lumber/timber bundles (green and kiln dried)
- Sort and stage material by species/grade/ dimensions/job requirements
- Count, measure, and label product with high accuracy (piece counts, lengths, bundle tags, job tags)
- Follow production instructions for stacking patterns, dunnage placement, and package stability
- Support basic quality checks (e.g., obvious defects, damage, mislabels, mixed lengths)
- Maintain clean, safe work areas (housekeeping, debris removal, clear walkways)
- Work within our safety program and SOPs (PPE, lockout awareness, traffic rules, lifting practices)
- Other production support duties as assigned

Qualifications Required

- Comfortable with physical work (lifting, bending, twisting, repetitive motions, standing/walking)
- Strong counting and measuring skills with a proven ability to stay accurate under pace
- Able to read and follow work orders, tags, and labeling instructions
- Safety-minded, reliable, and able to take direction from an Area Lead / Supervisor
- Willingness to work around machinery and forklifts and follow site traffic rules
- Legally entitled to work in Canada

- Previous experience in a sawmill, reman plant, lumber yard, or manufacturing environment
